## MAROR

Vodka, Golden and Red Beets,  
Horseradish



*Bitter herb symbolizing  
the harsh conditions the  
Jews endured as slaves.*

## CHAZERET

Gin, Sweet Vermouth,  
Artichoke Liqueur, Lemon Juice



*Second bitter herb to  
represent the severity of  
life in Egypt for the Jews.*

## CHAROSET

Manuka Honey Vodka,  
Sweet Vermouth, Cinnamon



*Represents the mortar used  
by Jewish slaves to build  
the cities of Ancient Egypt.*

## KARPAS

Gin, Italian Parsley,  
Balsamic Vinegar



*Vegetable dipped in salt water  
or vinegar to remember the  
tears shed by slaves.*

## Z'ROA

Bourbon, Ruby Port, Gum Syrup,  
Lemon Juice, Maraschino Liqueur



*Symbolizes the lamb sacrificed  
in the Temple in Jerusalem and  
eaten at the Seder meal.*

## BEITZAH

Apple Brandy, Bourbon,  
Benedictine, Galliano, Egg White



*Reminds us of the other  
festival sacrifice offered in  
the Temple in Jerusalem.*
